# HOW TO USE WoundClot™ Haemastatic Dressing to stop a bleed

Identify / Expose the wound

Identify the point of bleeding

Wipe away excess blood where possible.

Remove WoundClot™ from packet



If required, cut or tear WoundClot™ to the necessary size to suit the wound then place directly onto the wound. WoundClot™ can be formed to 'fit' any wound or site where rapid coagulation is required. Pack the wound with WoundClot™ if required.

Cover WoundClot™ with an appropriate dressing and apply direct pressure until bleeding is controlled /stops.

Wrap with a bandage to maintain pressure and seek further medical assistance.

### How to use it

#### **PACK**

Pack any cavity with Celox Gauze.

#### **PRESS**

Compress the wound to push the Celox Gauze on the area where the blood is coming from and stop blood flow for a short period while the Celox plug develops and strengthens.

Compress for 3 minutes or 1 minute with Celox Rapid Call EMS and extract asap to medical services.



### IMPORTANT

Points to remember

#### SERIOUS BLEEDING

Remember to wear gloves. To control bleeding apply pressure to the wound, apply a pressure dressing directly over the wound. If blood comes through dressing, remove and apply another dressing. Once bleeding controlled, activate EMS if needed or transport to medical help

## CATASTROPHIC BLEEDING - TOURNIQUETS

With limbs, you can apply a tourniquet tightly above the injury site but not over a joint till the bleeding stops. If required, apply another above the first. Note the time it was applied and tell EMS.

#### CATASTROPHIC BLEEDING -HAEMOSTATIC DRESSING

Clear worst of blood to identify source. Apply Haemostatic dressing into the wound, apply pressure for required time. Apply trauma dressing and note time applied. Tuck wrapper under bandage for EMS.
